2021-2022 UNIFORM POLICY

Important Notes:

- All students should be well groomed.
- Uniforms must be clean without holes.
- If bottoms have beltloops, a belt MUST be worn.
- No oversized or tight-fitting clothes. Uniform must fit to size.
- No oversized jackets. Jackets must be kept unzipped or unbuttoned inside the building.
- Hats, hoods and/or gloves are not allowed to be worn inside.
- Only Stud Earrings are allowed in ears (girls ONLY) and NO other body piercings are allowed.
- Boys are NOT allowed to wear earrings.
- Hair must be of a natural color (no colored hair extensions) and secured away from face.
- No distracting headbands – NO ears or horns.
- No hair picks.
- Nails must be trimmed short, no artificial nails, and no nail polish (strictly enforced).
- Jewelry: No large, dangling, distracting jewelry, necklaces, or bracelets.
- NO make-up or body art allowed.

- Shirts must be always tucked into pants.
- Only solid white undershirts.
- Socks are crew length solid white, solid black or navy blue.
- Girls may wear knee length white socks with their skort.
- All outerwear (jackets, sweaters, coats, and blazers) must be solid colors with no logos or decorations- navy, blue or black.
- **No Crocs, Boots, Rain Boots, Sandals, Heels, Wheelies, Lights, or Slip-on shoes.**

Top: Girls

- Royal blue polo shirts or uniform plaid skirts with a white shirt.
- **ALL 5th grade students must wear GOLD POLO shirts (we want to recognize our seniors).**
- Girl's cross tie may be worn with Peter Pan button down shirt.
- No Purses.
- All outerwear (jackets, sweaters, coats, and blazers) must be solid colors with no logos or decorations – navy, blue or black.

Bottom: Girls

- Khaki pants
- Knee length khaki shorts
- Plaid skorts available to purchase from Zoghby's Uniform store.
- White or black tights or ankle length leggings (worn with socks).

Belt: Girls

- Navy, brown, or black belt
- No design or large buckles
- No decorations

Socks: Girls

- Socks must be crew length
- Solid white, solid black or navy blue.
- White or black tights or ankle length leggings (worn with socks).
- No jeggings worn as pants. No spandex/tight or form fitting material.

Shoes: Girls

- Only tennis shoes.

Top: Boys

- Royal blue polo shirts or white button-down shirt worn with blue tie.
- **ALL 5th grade students must wear GOLD POLO shirts.**
- All outerwear (jackets, sweaters, coats, and blazers) must be solid colors with no logos or decorations – navy, blue or black.

Bottom: Boys

- Khaki pants or knee length shorts
- No oversized or sagging pants or shorts
- If bottoms have beltloops, a belt MUST be worn.

Belt: Boys

- Navy, brown, or black belt
- No design or large buckles (no name brand belt buckles)
- No decorations

Socks: Boys

- Socks must be crew length
- Solid white, solid black or navy blue.

Shoes: Boys

- Only tennis shoes.
