She did explain that the state scores all children and expects 1 year of growth even for those children that are above grade level at the beginning of the year.

Jodi Short and April Greene discussed how our Better Seeking Team has been restructured to a more student achievement team. Their focus instructional practices and student gains. We have small teams to address operations issues. They meet as needed. These are led by teacher leaders.

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Dr. Greene discussed the "Behind the Glass" parent learning sessions that will be happening in November. More information will be sent home.

There was no new business.

With no additional discussions, a motion to adjourn was made by Jodi Short. Shela McCracken seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
