Registration is now open for the 2020-2021 school year. We encourage you to complete the registration online to help us plan for the next school year. We know that families are making financial decisions and tuition may play into that decision. Please know that the MLC Board has frozen tuition for the 2020-2021 school year. We want all of our students to return to MLC, and not have the tuition expense be a deterring factor. Please contact the MLC office if you'd like to talk to someone about financial aid.

Finally, even though the COVID-19 virus is raging throughout the world, so is generosity. We see generosity in our community and at MLC. **We know that every family's financial situation is unique, and if your family would need the remaining lunch and transportation funds returned, MLC would be happy to do so.** In this case, please contact the MLC office with your reimbursement request. We would, however, ask for your generosity in considering a donation of the remaining lunch and transportation funds for the academic school year. Most families have already paid this amount to MLC. Please keep the financial health of MLC in your thoughts and prayers.

Enrollment time for the 2020-2021 school year has arrived. All enrollment will take place online via Parent's Web. You should have received an email with instructions on enrolling your child(ren) (and setting up a Parent's Web account, if necessary). The enrollment fee is due and payable with your child's enrollment. There is no change to the enrollment fees and tuition for 2020-2021 school year. We continue to provide a discount for early enrollment. Below are enrollment fees for your information.
