8th Grade Bible Syllabus

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Course Description: A study of the basic tools and skills for understanding and researching the Scriptures.

Course Objectives:

- 1. To acquaint the student with the Bible: its background and purpose.
- 2. To develop personal skills at reading the Word, gaining insights, and recording them for future use.
- 3. To equip each student with the basic resources and methodology to do informative studies in the Bible.

Course Requirements:

- 1. Class participation- Students will be expected to take good notes and to engage in class discussion each day.
- 2. Assignments- Students will be given reading and written assignments to be completed each week. This will include in-class assignments as well as homework.
- 3. Tests and Exams- Eight (8) tests will be given during the semester and one (1) semester exam will be given at the end of the semester.
