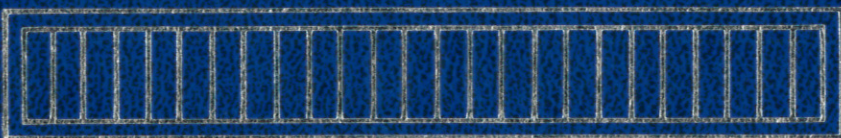

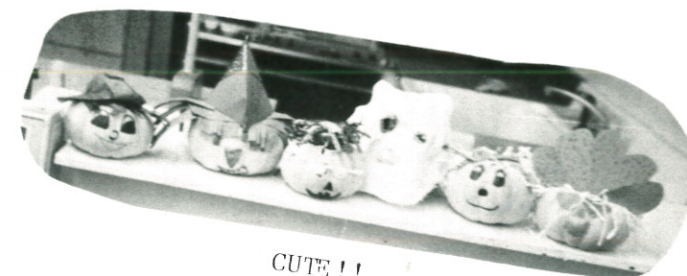
I, Bonnie Michelle Edwards, hereby bequeath my worldly possessions to the following people to be dispensed with as stated.
