Quitman County School District Revised Grading Guidelines

The information below provides guidance for grading, retention, and promotion policies for the 2019-2020 academic school year:

These guidelines are to ensure Quitman County students are not penalized for conditions beyond their control and to ensure that students are not held back in their K-12 progression as a result of the COVID-19 school closure.

Elementary & Middle School

- No state or local assessments will be administered during the 4th nine weeks
- Final grades for students in Prek-8th grade will be calculated as the average of the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd nine weeks' grades.
- Work completed during the 4th nine weeks will only be used to improve a student's grade.
- Students who have not earned a grade of 70 or higher at the end of the 3rd nine weeks must complete assignments to improve their final grade.
- Students will continue to receive assignments through May 15, 2020.
- All student grades will be entered by May 22, 2020
- Report cards will be mailed the week of May 25th to the address we have on file
- Additional summer learning resources will be provided by the school. Details are forthcoming.

High School

- No state or local assessments will be administered during the 4th nine weeks
- Final grades for students in high school will be calculated based on their average as of March 17, 2020.
- Work completed after March 17, 2020 will be used to improve a student's grade.
- Students who had not earned a grade of 70 or higher by March 17, 2020 must complete
 assignments to improve their final grade and receive credit for the course.
- Students will continue to receive assignments through May 15, 2020.
- All student grades will be entered by May 22, 2020.
- Report cards will be mailed the week of May 25th to the address we have on file
- Additional summer learning resources will be provided by the school. Details are forthcoming.
