Hello, Families! I am very excited that all staff members who are interested and able to get a vaccine will have their first dose within the next week. I also want to let you know that sometimes adults do have a reaction to the vaccine, usually the second dose, developing flu-like symptoms that are non-contagious but do last up to 24 hours. You know that I will do everything I can to keep the school open. However, if I am not able to cover all of the classrooms, I may have to switch to a remote learning day. We will not know until the very last minute that we have to make this change. I am most concerned about the possibility of needing a remote learning day on Monday, March 29 and/or Wednesday, March 31. The staff members have been so extraordinary this year, working together and being here every day to support all learners. We were not given flexibility in selecting the dates for our vaccines. Thank you in advance for understanding, if I do need to hold a remote learning day.

Free WiFi on School Grounds: The State of Connecticut has brought free WiFi to our school grounds. We were one of the first to sign-up and receive the hardware needed to offer you free WiFi.
