We are proud to announce that SJRCS has earned the “Power of Teaching Badge” for the 2020-2021 school year!

During the 2020-2021 school year, PBIS Maryland modified the school recognition process to best reflect the learning environment during the COVID-19 pandemic. Temporarily replacing the traditional “Gold, Silver, Bronze” recognition process, PBIS Maryland introduced “Badges” to be awarded to schools that continued to implement PBIS standards during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The “Power of Teaching Badge” provides an opportunity to highlight how the PBIS team was innovative in leveraging teaching and acknowledgement strategies to support staff and students during the COVID-19 pandemic. Such innovations include:

- Staff continued to teach students the routines and expectations in the virtual learning environment. Routines and expectations are aligned with the schoolwide expectations.
- The Behavior matrix was modified to include remote learning environments, asynchronous routines, synchronous routines, hybrid learning situations.
