


## How to Place Books on Hold in Destiny Discover

With Destiny Discover™, it is easy to find, check out and read eBooks.



#### Accessing Destiny Discover

From the Clever app click the Follett Destiny button under More Apps.  Click the heart to add it to your favorites. You can also use the link in the library section of our school website [causeytigers.com](http://causeytigers.com) or go to [bit.ly/causeylibrary](http://bit.ly/causeylibrary).

Type your MCPSS Username and Password, and then tap Submit. Do not include @stu.mcpss.com at the end of your user name.

If you are looking for a specific title, author, or subject, type it into the search bar and click the magnifying glass.

Use the ribbons on the homepage to find books that were recently added, popular titles, or specific topics. Click See All to view all the titles available in each category.
