October 10, 2011**

Dr. Bill King, Jr. called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by the board president, Dr. Bill King, Jr.

There were twenty-four (24) in attendance with nineteen (19) as guests. Questions were taken and discussed regarding the closure of Andalusia Middle School.

- Consideration of Bond Referendum** Superintendent Ted Watson recommended the approval of a \$5.5 million bond referendum contingent upon a commitment of the city's 2.5 mills per year. Upon a motion by Amy Dugger, seconded by David McCalman, this was approved. The vote was 3 to 1 with Joe Nix opposing.
