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## Summit Learning Policy SUMMIT LERINING

Projects: 70% Power Focus: 21% Additional Focus Areas: 9%

Challenge Focus Area: Reading Checks (required for ALL students)

What is required? If a student If a student's Summit account says "Off Track," he/she is not passing due to one of the following reasons:

- 1. Complete all projects.
- 2. Complete all Power Focus Areas as the progress bar passes them.
- 3. Complete all reading checks located in the Challenge Focus Area.
- 4. Maintain a cognitive skill average of 70% or higher.

**How do I know my grade?** Grades are automatically calculated & viewable in the Summit platform. Parents should regularly check your child's Summit to keep track of their progress throughout the year!

\*Progress reports will be sent home at the end of each 9 weeks.

Final grades are NOT an average of 4 quarter grades in the year. The grade shown on the progress report is a snapshot of the student's current standing in the class, which will likely fluctuate throughout the year. The student's final grade will be issued at the end of the 4th 9 weeks period when the course has been completed.

#### Focus Area Assessment Policy

- 1st Attempt:
  - a) Students may take an assessment for the 1st time if they make a 100% on the diagnostic the FIRST time they attempt it.
  - b) If students do not make a 100% on first take of diagnostic, they must complete the provided note sheet & get it stamped by me before being allowed to take an assessment.
- 2nd & Subsequent Attempts:

To retake a failed assessment, students must provide new evidence of learning (additional notes, passing scores on practice exercises, small group tutoring, etc.) for objectives not passed before he/she will be allowed to retest. New evidence of learning is required before every assessment attempt.

• Reading Checks/ Challenge Focus Areas:

Reading Checks hold students accountable for completing the required reading. They are not typical focus areas. Reading Checks will be taken at designated times in class not on SDL days. Students will not be able to pass if they have not done the reading! If a student does not pass the Reading Check, he/she must complete the required reading review notes before being allowed to reassess. Projects will be Incomplete until all of the associated Reading Checks have been passed.

#### Honors

To earn the honors designation for English 9, students will be required to complete additional advanced reading and assignments above and beyond the General English 9 curriculum. We will be using the A+College Ready Pre-AP curriculum. Students in this class are preparing to take either AP Language & Composition or dual-enrollment English Composition 101 their 11th grade year. Students must complete & pass with unquestionable proficiency all required honors reading and activities to receive honors credit, including all Challenge Focus Areas.

#### **Assignments Not Completed**

- Students are responsible for completing & turning in all checkpoints & projects on the assigned due date!
- Checkpoints are required not optional.
- Checkpoints not turned in on the due date will NOT receive feedback & will be marked red in Summit. I will not give feedback for late work!
- If not turning in work on time becomes a habit for a student, I will report them to administration for further
  action.
- ALL projects & power focus areas must be completed for students to be promoted to 9th grade. If work is not finished during the regular school year, the student will be required to attend summer school or repeat 8th grade English.
