The U.S. History assessment utilizes an embedded field-test design and will consist of Multiple Choice (MC) items, Technology-Enhanced (TE) items, and Constructed-Response (CR) [Text Entry/Short Response] items which are described below.

Item Type	Points	Description
Multiple Choice (MC)	1	Each has four response options, only one of which is correct; used to assess a variety of skill levels, from short-term recall of information to inference and problem solving; each of these items is worth one point.
Technology-Enhanced (TE)	1 Or 2	Each is designed to elicit evidence of a broad range of student understanding; student interacts with enhanced features of these computer-delivered, <u>auto-scorable</u> test items to show understanding of skills and concepts; includes the drag-and-drop, hot-spot, number line, data displays, matching interaction, and drop-down menus, etc.; scored on a 0-1 or 0-2-point scale using item-specific scoring rules.
Constructed Response (CR)* [Text Entry/Short Response]	2	Each is designed to assess skills in a way a traditional multiple-choice item cannot. Each of these Text Entry items or Short Response items (i.e., multiple select response items, multi-part items include two parts (Part A and Part B), sequenced items) are <u>autoscored</u> on a 0-2-point scale using item-specific scoring guidelines.

**\*Please Note:** The CR items are not essay based. These will be scored by a machine so the typed answers will be very short.
