BACK-TO-SCHOOL CHECKLIST

- **School starts Wednesday, August 19**
 - As a reminder, all students will be dropped off at the curb in front of the school. For safety reasons, no adults--including parents--may enter the campus. Only staff and students may come inside the gate.
 - School uniforms are required for both On Campus and Distance Learning
 - PE shoes should be worn all day long in all grades PK3 through grade 8. See Dress Code on website for PE shoe details.

- **August 17, 6 pm PK3 - PK4 Virtual Parent Meeting -** Join the meeting by clicking on the following link: <https://meetings.ringcentral.com/j/4531648027> The link will prompt you to download the Ring Central Meetings app if you don't already have it downloaded on your device. Please log in at least 10 minutes prior to the start of the meeting.

- **Aug. 17-18, 9am to 5 pm Pick Up Materials for Distance Learning** *If your children are coming to school on campus – do not come to pick up materials!*
 - Pk3-Grade 3 go to gate by courtyard; call 904-705-3827 to be buzzed in to the Cafeteria
 - Grades 4-8 go to main Gym Door
 - Be attentive to social distancing
 - Wear a mask
 - State child's name and grade
 - Bring a bag or backpack to put students books/materials in.

- **School Supplies for Students Attending on Campus**
 - Because of COVID-19, school supplies will not be shared in community. On the first day of school, only send enough of your child's personal supplies to get started. For example, don't send in 12 pencils right away. Limit the amount of each item. If you do that, there may be no need to drop off school supplies in advance.
 - Parents who feel the need to drop off in advance, however, should put their child's items in a bag clearly marked with the child's name and grade. **Follow the directions in the previous section for Pick Up of Distance Learning materials when dropping off supplies.** PK and kindergarten parents may want to bring nap mats in ahead of time if your child is unable to carry it into school on the first day.

- **Due August 18: Sign Documents required to start school. Log in to your Family Portal and click on Web Forms in the left column to review the documents and sign them digitally:**

- COVID-19 Waiver
- Parent Agreement for Distance Learning OR
- Parent Agreement for On Campus Learning

- **Download the app**
