


Mrs. Treasure's Buccaneer Bulletin

Theme: Back to School/Friendship

Reading: We will read *Huggapotamus* by Steve Metzger and *The Crayon Box That Talked* by Shane Derolf. We will focus on the story elements (characters especially), the job of the author and illustrator, and the problems and solutions in our stories.

Letter Bootcamp: F, G, H, I, and J

Writing: We will continue using our writing journals daily. We are working on narrative stories. Our focus is drawing a picture with labels. We are also working to draw in a designated space and to write letters and words on the lines.

Math: This week we will focus on the numbers 6-10. Our goals will be writing the numerals, counting 6-10 objects, understanding that one object represents one number, and understanding that the last number said aloud when counting means that is the number of items represented.
