## **5TH GRADE ART LESSON WEEK 4**

In this lesson you will be making a sculpture in the style of Alberto Giacometti. Giacometti is a famous Swiss artist who worked in several mediums. He is famous for his sculptures of human forms. They look a lot like stick people. His sculptures of the human form reduce the body to its essential elements, something no other artist had done before him. It had a big influence on the minimalist movement. Below are some examples of his work.



Supplies: Foil Scissors

For this lesson you will be using foil to create a human figure sculpture in the style of Giacometti. I will add a series of images that will help you. <u>I will also add a link to a youtube tutorial here</u> if you need to check that out.

\*\*Keep in mind that foil is easily ripped. Work carefully and slowly. If it doesn't work the first time, try again!

**Optional**: See if you can put your foil person in famous positions. Like dabbing, taking an oath or saying a prayer.
