RETURN TO FACE TO FACE INSTRUCTION



TAKE IN AND DISMISSAL

When students arrive they will report to first block by 7:10 AM.

When students are dismissed at 2:25, buses will run their regular schedule. Car riders may be picked up in the front of the campus.



BREAKFAST/LUNCH

Breakfast will be served from 6:40 AM- 7:05 AM.

Lunch will be served during 3rd block.

Remote learners will be able to pick up their meals on Mondays from 9 AM-1 PM.



UNIFORMS

Uniforms are required everyday, along with a face covering.

Tops: Solid red, gray, or white polo style or button down shirt with long or short sleeves.

Bottoms: Gray standard uniform slacks, such as a "Dockers style" slacks; cotton or blend twill; fitted and belted at waist; full length to ankle

Belts: solid black/ brown



LAPTOPS AND SUPPLIES

Students will need the following supplies:

- Laptop
- Charger
- Wired earbuds (no bluetooth)
- Carrying Case
- Flash drive
- Personal Water bottle

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WILL STUDENTS BE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS?

Students up will be required to wear face coverings or masks. Younger students are strongly encouraged to wear masks. Masks cannot contain inappropriate images or words or any political messages.

WILL STUDENTS CHANGE CLASSES?

Hallways will be one way and students will have minimum class changes.

Will schools conduct temperature checks on students?

No, unless an individual student shows symptoms of illness, in which case he/she will immediately go to first aid. Parents are asked to check temperatures and to carefully screen their students for illness each day before sending them to school.

Can students attend some classes on campus, and some remotely?

No, students must choose between returning to school and remote learning.

CAN WE CHANGE OUR MIND ABOUT RETURNING OR REMOTE LEARNING? HOW LONG WILL REMOTE LEARNING CONTINUE?

Unless a child must quarantine, necessitating the use of remote learning, all students will be allowed to change their decision once. The Superintendent will decide after first quarter whether to continue offering remote learning.
