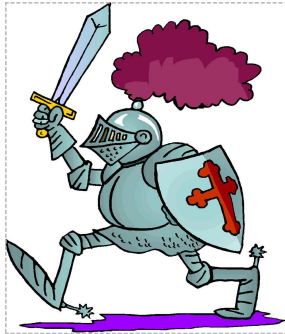

### Signed Papers/Purple Folders
