May 11, 2020

On Monday, May 11, 2020 the members of the Lanett City School Board (Pres. Gwen Harris-Brooks, Vice Pres. Tony Edmondson, David Gagnon, Gail Holley and Katie Walton) along with Superintendent Jennifer Boyd, Whittany Nolen, LJHS/LHS Counselor YaShika Odom and Suzzanne Vaughn met at Lanett High School Media Center for the board's regular monthly meeting. Due to continued statewide "**shelter in place**" order, the meeting could not be held in the normal manner.
