DISCIPLINE & DISCHARGE

Children are entitled to a pleasant and harmonious environment at the 21st Century Programs. The 21st Century cannot serve children who display chronically disruptive behavior. Chronically disruptive behavior is defined as verbal or physical activity which may include but is not limited to such behavior that:

- Requires constant attention from the staff
- Inflicts physical or emotional harm on other children
- Abuses the staff
- Ignores or disobeys the rules which guide behavior
- Refuses to participate in the activities

If a child cannot adjust to the 21st Century Program setting and behave appropriately, then the child may be discharged.

Reasonable efforts will be made to assist children to adjust to the 21st Century Program setting. Disruptive behavior will be dealt with in the following manner:

1. The misbehaving child will be given a chance to think about his/her actions.
2. If the incident is severe enough, an incident report will be written. This report will be given to the parent or guardian to read and sign. A copy will be given to the principal and school day consequences will be given if deemed necessary. The child will then be asked to stay home for the next two days of the program. Parents will be notified, and asked to schedule a conference to develop a behavioral plan if needed.
3. If a child receives three written behavior-related incident reports within a program year, the child will be suspended. In order for a child to be reinstated, a conference will be held with the parent/guardian and a member of the 21st Century Staff.
4. If the severity of a problem is great enough discharge will be effective immediately.

I have read the discipline requirements of the 21st Century Program, and understand that I must obey the rules in order to stay in the 21st Century Program.
