Scholarship Criteria and Rules

1. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded.
2. Student must be a graduating senior during the 2013-2014 school year.
3. Preference will be given to a student majoring in Agriculture. Students enrolling in a technical school or community college are still eligible as long as they are pursuing a career related to the agriculture field or plan to transfer to a university to study agriculture.
4. Scholarship will be awarded after the first fall semester and transcript/grades are submitted to Farm Bureau.
5. Recipients will be selected based on academics, school and community involvement, need, and agriculture background.
6. Applications are due to the school guidance office or Smithville Farm Bureau by **March 20, 2014**. Late entries will not be accepted.
