Reading Instruction

Objectives

- 1st grade students will move from 37% proficiency on the DIBELS 8 ORF to 75% by May 2020.
- 2nd grade students will achieve 82 SIP by the end of year using Performance Series Reading.
- 2nd grade will move from 73% proficiency on the DIBELS 8 ORF to 80% proficiency by May 2020.

Critical Initiatives

- Reaching all learners: differentiated instruction, multi-sensory and RTI strategies will be incorporated through both whole and small group lessons in language arts for all students.
- Teachers will provide instruction based on research-based best practices to all students.

Math Instruction

Objectives

- 1st Grade will move from 52 SIP proficiency on Math PS Express assessment to 56 SIP by May 2020.
- 2nd grade will move from 60 SIP proficiency on Math PS Express assessment to 73 SIP by May 2020.
