Rules for the basketball players:

- Basketball players, who have not completed assignments in class or have not gotten their homework finished from the night before and turned in to the teacher's specification, will miss practice and work on the missing work.
- 2. If a student receives an **F** on their report card or on progress report, he/she will be off the team until the grades are made up. If the student receives 2 **F**'s, they are off the team for the rest of the season.
- 3. If the player is sick the day of game and they are not in school or checked out because of sickness, the player will not be playing in game.
- 4. If the student is doing makeup test after being absent, the student is exempt from missing specialty classes.
- 5. After an absent, any work that needs to be turn in can be done at recess not during specialty classes.
- 6. Players who miss P.E. for a medical reason cannot practice basketball that day or play in that night's game.
- 7. If your child has a Doctor's appointment which is for medical, dental or vision, they will be allowed to play that night.
- 8. Playing basketball is a privilege here at Broadview. We do expect good behavior and grades from the players. If your child can not abide by the school or class rules, he/she will be taken off of the ball team. This will be at Mrs. Schultz's

discretion after conferencing with parent and their teacher.
