Chronological Order - Events that are arranged in the order they happened.

Decades - A time period of ten years.

Centuries - A time period of 100 years.

Events - Something that happens, especially things that are important.

Timeline - Related events in chronological order.

Primary Source - Records of events as they were first described. They were witnessed by people involved in the event.

Secondary Source - Information that was created by someone who did not experience something first hand.

Artifact - A material object of a culture such as a tool, an article of clothing or a type of food.
