**Dear Parent/Guardian:**

Magnet parents needing transportation for their students will select a pick-up site at the middle school campus nearest their homes. This site will be the designated site for both mornings and afternoons- **NO EXCEPTIONS**. If your child does not attend Clark, they will not be allowed on campus as this is not a drop-off/pick-up site. If your child misses his/her bus, you will need to take them to their designated school. Route schedules are available at [www.mcpss.com](http://www.mcpss.com).

Students should be at their designated pick-up site at least five minutes before pick-up time. Due to the number of students boarding the bus, students need to be in line waiting for the bus (NOT IN CARS). Buses are on a schedule and will not be able to wait on students when it's time to leave. It is also the parent's/guardian's responsibility to be at the selected school in the afternoon to pick the student up when the bus arrives. **No students are to be left unattended at any school site.** Please use caution at your designated site when students are loading/unloading. The transfer hub for magnet students attending Denton, Dunbar and Phillips is on the campus of Clark-Shaw (formerly Shaw High School).

**\*\*Students who are dropped off/picked up at Causey, must use the same traffic flow pattern as Causey Middle. You are to enter from Jeff Hamilton, circle around by the walkway, unload/load and exit onto McFarland ONLY. DO NOT CUT THROUGH OR PARK IN THE PARKING LOT. This also includes the bus parking lot. If this is not followed, your child will NOT be allowed to ride the bus.**
