Legal Notice: Annual AHERA Notification Letter

Dear Parents/Guardians, School Staff, Temporary Workers and or Contractors:

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). As a result of this act, our facilities were inspected for asbestos containing building materials and their conditions assessed. The materials are re-inspected and reassessed every three years. We continue to monitor the conditions of these materials through our on going six-month surveillance program. It is our districts intent to comply with federal, state and local regulations governing asbestos to ensure a safe environment for our students, staff and visitors.

Pursuant to the Federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) mandate, as required by 40 CFR 763.84 (c)(d) of public access to environmental records, this letter is to acknowledge the availability of our facilities Asbestos Management Plan. Piedmont City Schools, as the Local Education Agency (LEA), retains such reports that are available for public inspection in the Office of the Principal or the Administration Building during regular school hours.
