Re-Opening Plan for In-Person Learners

Masks & Uniforms

- Students in grades 2-5 & Staff will wear masks upon entering the building, in the hallways, transitions, during small groups, and as needed in ANY areas in which social distancing cannot be maintained, including classrooms.
- Students will **not** be required to wear masks while eating breakfast/lunch.
- Students can bring a mask from home or they will be provided with a mask on the first day of face to face instruction.
- Uniforms are to be worn daily.

Classrooms

- According to CDC guidelines, social distancing will be maintained as much as possible.
- Students will have assigned seats/areas. For safety reasons, students will not be allowed to leave their assigned seat/area.
- Students will use their own supplies/devices.
- **No** sharing of materials or supplies will be allowed.
- All students must bring snacks from home. Students will not be allowed to share snacks throughout the day.

Health & Safety

- Students will wash/sanitize hands upon entering the classroom and multiple times throughout the day.
- Sanitization will be a priority throughout the building.
- Students will adhere to a restroom schedule allowing for a small group of students to be in the restroom at one time. **Restrooms will be monitored daily by adult supervision.**

Physical Education

- Students will be able to participate in P.E.
- Masks are **not** required during PE.
- Social distancing will be maintained.
- Bottled water will be sold for \$1 during PE. Water fountains have been turned off.

Arrival & Dismissal

- Parents should check their child's temperature before coming to school or putting them on the bus.
- Buses will run as normal. Students are required to wear masks and sit with siblings on the bus. Students without siblings will be assigned seating by the bus driver.
- Parents may **not** walk students into the school.
- Students will enter and exit the building through designated hallway entry doors. **All** student traffic in the building will proceed in one direction.
- Students tardy to school must be accompanied by a parent to the door before admittance of the student to the building.
- Parent and visitor access to the school is restricted at this time.
- **No** early dismissals will be permitted after 2:00pm.
- Students will remain in classrooms until dismissed by pods (bus/daycare vans), walkers, then car riders. Staff will supervise students during this transition.
- As transitioning through the halls, students will be supervised and will be spaced 6 feet apart as much as possible.
- Tiger Care is not available at this time.

Breakfast & Lunch

- While masks are worn daily, students will remove their masks to eat. Once the meal is completed, the student will immediately put on their masks.
- Each meal will be held in the student's classroom.
- Students can bring their lunch to school. Student lunches brought to school should not require heating or re-heating.
