

March 16, 2020 – Statewide School Closure Message

Dear Hodgen Public School parents and staff:

On March 16, 2020 the state Board of Education voted to close all Oklahoma schools, effective immediately, until at least April 6 in an effort to minimize the spread of COVID-19. This closure includes Hodgen Public Schools. No school or school activities will take place during this time.

We do not expect that Oklahoma schools will be required to make-up the missed days. And, at this time, school have been instructed by the state Department of Education not to provide online, home-based or distance learning for students.

This situation continues to evolve by the hour. We understand that these uncertainties are worrisome and problematic for many. Rest assured that Hodgen School is doing everything in its power to ensure the needs of students will be met.

We encourage everyone to comply with what health officials have recommended as well. If you can, please stay home and enjoy family time. If you must go out, please practice social distancing, allowing at least six feet between you and other individuals.
