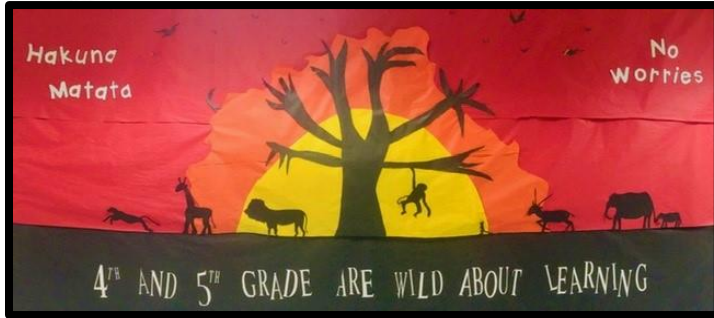

Preparing for the Georgia Milestones

If you are a parent of a 3rd, 4th, or 5th grader, your child will be

taking the Georgia Milestones Test in April. The Georgia Milestones is a comprehensive end-of-grade assessment. It measures how well students learned the material and skills outlined in the state-adopted content standards. Scientific Studies have proven that the following **Test-Taking Tips** will help students do better on standardized tests.

Please make sure your child:

- Gets enough sleep by going to bed early on nights before the test
- Gets to school early (If students are late for the test they will not take that section with their class and will have to make-up the missed part later.)
- Wears his or her glasses, if applicable
- Wears comfortable clothing
- Eats a good breakfast

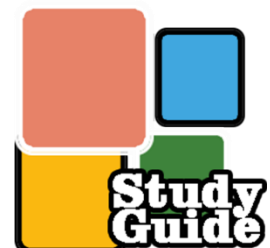

Fire and Life Safety Essay Contest

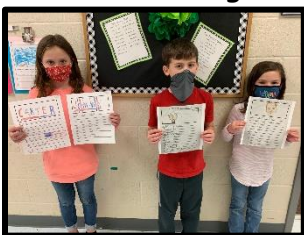
15 students across Georgia were named winners of the Fire and Life Safety Essay Contest and three of them were our very own students from Kings Chapel! Congratulations to the
