Bylaws of the Board

Office of the Vice-Chairperson

The Vice-Chairperson will:

- 1. Act in place of the Chairperson when necessary and preside at meetings when the Chairperson is temporarily absent.
- 2. The Vice-Chairperson cannot fill vacancies required to be filled by the Chairperson.
- Work with the Chairperson and Superintendent to become generally informed of Board business.
- 4. In the absence of the Chairperson, act as a resource to the Superintendent on decisions which may require further input between Board meetings.
- 5. In case of illness, resignation, or death of the Chairperson, the Vice-Chairperson, as deemed by the Board, becomes Chairperson for the unexpired term.

The Vice-Chairperson's signature shall be an alternative signature on all legal documents requiring the signature of the Secretary.
