Pearl & Jesse Savage Memorial Scholarship Fund

The intent of the **Pearl & Jesse Savage Memorial Scholarship Fund** is to promote a higher level of education for graduates of Grundy County High School in Coalmont, Tennessee. Funds will be distributed in the form of scholarships to selected recipients planning to further their education at any 2 and 4-year University, College, or Technical School within the State of Tennessee. Recipients can receive scholarships for up to 4 years. In order to be eligible for scholarships during their sophomore, junior and senior years of college – the student must apply during their senior year at Grundy County High School.

The Scholarship is available to any Grundy County High School Graduate who enrolls in a postsecondary institution residing in the State of Tennessee. One \$1,500 scholarship and one \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded during the 2008 – 2009 school year and during the following years. The \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a student with a declared major in Engineering, Math or Science. The \$1,500 scholarships are open to any graduating senior; however, a preference will be shown to students whose intended major is Engineering, Math or Science. These scholarships may be renewed for up to three additional years.

Suitable scholarship recipients must meet the following criteria:

- Must be in the upper 40 percent of the senior class academically,
- Must graduate from the Grundy County High School,
- Must not have a criminal record involving substance abuse,
- Must attend a post-secondary school by the fall semester following graduation,
- The parent's income is not sufficient to pay for their education.

Scholarship winners will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Academics Numerical average and rank, difficulty of curriculum, and ACT or SAT scores
- School and community activities or service
- The essay
- Financial Need

Preference will be shown towards students whose educational and career aspirations lean towards engineering, mathematics, and sciences.

The responsibilities of each selected scholarship recipient include:

- Must stay drug-free,
- Must maintain good moral character,
- Must pass 24 semester hours during each post-secondary year,
- Must maintain good standing with the post-secondary institution,
- Must be a full-time student,
- Must apply each year for a renewal award, and
- The program of study must be attended in consecutive semesters.
