The Fannin County Board of Education met in a called meeting with the following members present: Bobby Bearden, Chairperson; Lewis DeWeese, Vice-Chairperson; Terry Bramlett; Sandra Mercier; and Steve Stanley.

Moved, seconded, and carried to go into executive session to review an appeal from a Student Disciplinary Tribunal (Hearing Officer, Panel); (OCGA 20-2-757) and to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal, or periodic evaluation or rating of a public officer or employee; (O.C.G.A. 50-14-3(6)).

Moved, seconded, and carried to resume regular session.

Bobby Bearden, Chairperson, announced no action was taken during executive session.

Mr. Bearden stated while in executive session the Board reviewed a tribunal appeal involving a high school student who became intoxicated on campus and displayed disorderly conduct. Mr. Bearden stated the tribunal panel had determined that the student would be assigned placement at Crossroads Alternative School in Ellijay, Georgia until the end of the 2012-2013 school year or until he successfully completes his high school diploma. During the placement the student is banned from the high school campus indefinitely. Mr. Bearden made a motion for the Board to uphold the tribunal decision as rendered. Terry Bramlett seconded the motion. All members voted in favor to uphold the tribunal decision as rendered.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion duly made, seconded, and carried, the meeting adjourned.
