Warner Robins Middle Adds Little Free Library to Campus



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Warner Robins Middle School teacher, Wimberly Tyler, has added a "Little Free Library" to the campus. Students and community members may take a book to keep or return later, and may leave books to share with others. By providing free books, Tyler hopes to spark a love for reading.

Tyler, who teaches language arts to sixth graders, funded the Little Free Library with a Flint Energies Foundation *Bright Ideas* grant. She is pictured with the library, which is located next to the front doors of Warner Robins Middle. The school's Little Free Library is available at all times and will be stocked with books throughout the summer.

"When I applied for the Flint Energies grant, my goal was to spread a love of reading and provide easy access to books beyond my classroom and into the surrounding community," said Tyler. "I have loved

seeing the library empty and then restocking it from my stash of books. That means someone out there is having a new adventure between the pages of a book, and our school got to help make that happen! I hope this project helps cultivate not only a love of reading, but also a love of community service and involvement in our students."
