



## What do I do if COVID affects me during the holiday break?

If I test positive for COVID-19, I should quarantine for a <b>full 10 days</b> before returning to work and immediately notify close contacts.
If I am exposed to a person who tested positive for COVID-19 through close contact, <b>WITHIN 48 HOURS OF THEM TESTING POSITIVE</b> , I will quarantine for a <b>full 14 days</b> before returning to work.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I can return to work after quarantining 10 days from testing positive WITHOUT OBTAINING A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT.</li><li>• I can return to work after quarantining 14 days from exposure WITHOUT OBTAINING A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT.</li></ul>
If I have a positive COVID-19 test, <b>I do not have to quarantine or get tested again for up to 3 months</b> as long as I do not develop symptoms.
<i>*Close Contact</i> means: in the presence of an individual at less than 6 feet for greater than 15 minutes CUMULATIVE throughout the day
