

**July 14, 2021 FPTC Student Aid CRRSAA HEERF II  
Status of Emergency Relief to Students Reporting**

This is a posting of CRRSAA HEERF II "Student Portion" information for quarterly reporting compliance in accordance with the Section 18004(e) of the CARES Act:

1. Florida Panhandle Technical College (FPTC) signed and returned to the Department of Education, the Certification and Agreement statement. FPTC will use no less than 50 percent of the funds received from the CRRSAA HEERF II ACT to provide no less than 50% of the total Student and Institutional Emergency Financial Aid Grant Funds to students.
2. FPTC received a total of \$189,031.00 from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants directly to students, which was completely exhausted and distributed by November, 2020. Another \$189,301.00 for students was mirrored and provided to FPTC as additional funds, added to the original grants funds, and receive by FPTC in May 2020 under the **CRRSAA HEERF II ACT**.
3. As of this posting, \$133,639.00 of the CRRSAA HEERF II ACT has been directly provided to students who have exhibited "exceptional need" as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic.
4. The act required that eligible students be enrolled in an eligible Title IV CTE program, not be in default of loans, not have fraudulently received Title IV funds, and not be a dual enrollment or adult education learner. FPTC asks eligible students to complete a current FAFSA. All students receiving funds must complete a W9. Students who met these criteria, and had "exceptional needs" were eligible to apply for the funding during the Spring term.
5. The school provided another opportunity for eligible students to apply again during the Summer term. As of this writing, those funds have not been encumbered or distributed.
