Male Attire: Pants (Khakis are permitted) White collar shirt Dark tie or bow tie **NO shorts NO** jeans **NO T-Shirts NO tennis shoes** NO flip flops **NO hats**

Behavior and Expectations

- Graduation is a dignified, formal celebratory event which honors the hard work and sacrifice of each student and their families.
- <u>NO CELL PHONES ALLOWED</u> during the graduation ceremony.
- Dress code is strictly enforced at graduation practice as well as the graduation ceremony. Any
 student who does not adhere to the dress code will not be allowed to participate in the graduation
 ceremony.
- The rules and regulations outlined in the HCBOE will be enforced. Students who choose to not abide by these rules may be escorted from the arena and not allowed to participate in the graduation commencement.

GRADUATION INFORMATION

- Masks are required while in Reaves Arena.

Graduation Ceremony The Recessional

- Faculty Row leaders will distribute diplomas as graduates leave their row for the recessional.
- Pay attention to the diploma distribution directions from graduation practice.
- Graduates will follow their row leader and fellow graduates out of the arena.
- Meet your family and guests at the clock tower.

A few things to consider

- Please note that the graduation ceremony is not over until you reach the clock tower.
- You will receive an empty diploma case when you walk across the stage.
