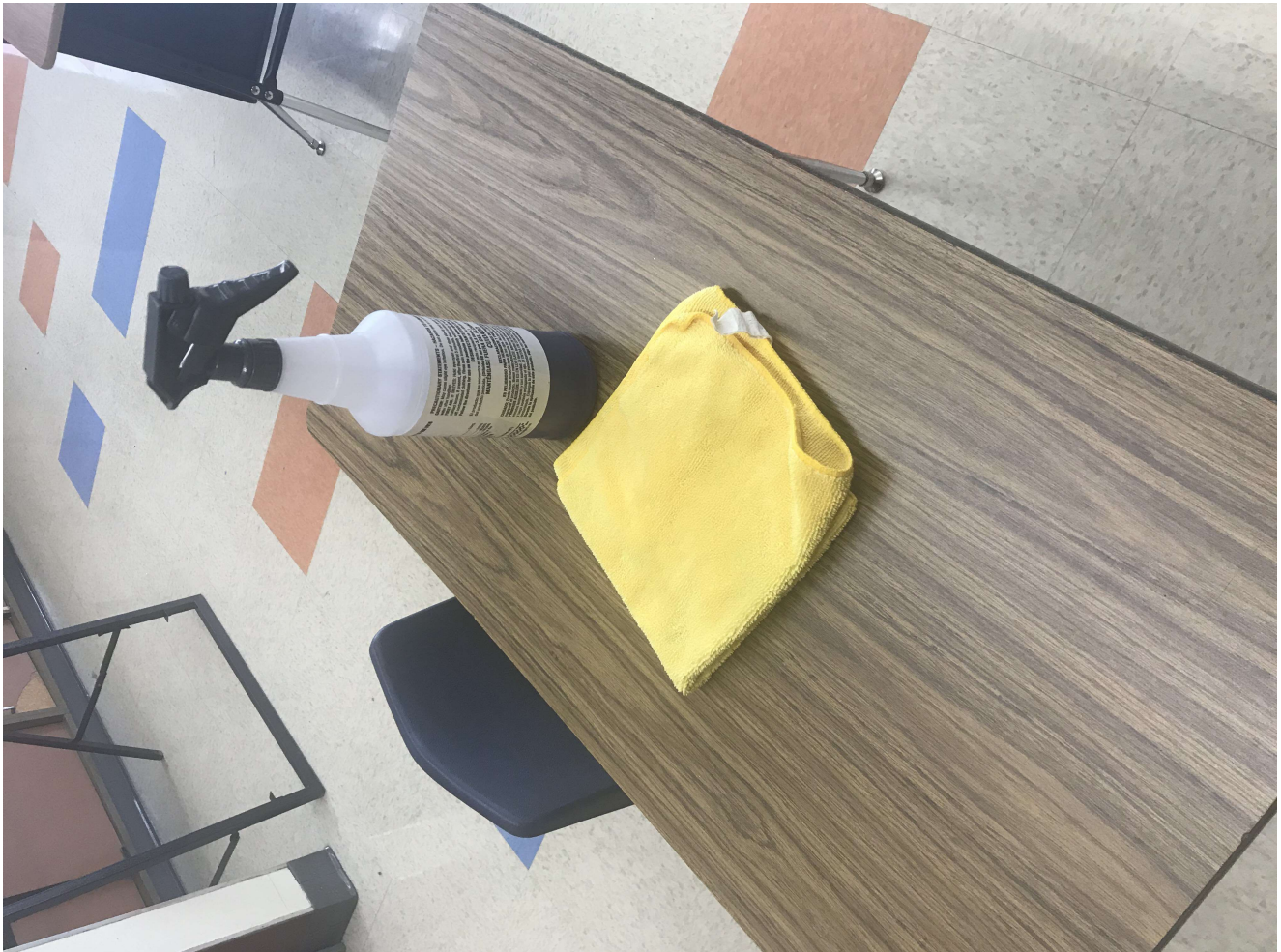


## Safety – Sanitation

**When is sanitizing happening?** There is ongoing sanitizing of public spaces frequented by students during the day (i.e. keeping bathrooms clean) and nightly cleaning of commonly touched surfaces. One of the reasons most students are not attending school on Wednesdays is so that the custodial staff can deep clean the building between cohorts. This means sanitizing commonly touched surfaces, including, but not limited to student desks, student chairs, classroom equipment, keypads, handles etc.

Deep cleaning will again occur on Friday afternoon after the cohort has left in preparation for the new group on Monday morning.



**What about playgrounds?** Additionally, playground equipment will be cleaned between each recess period and a fifteen minute “gap” will exist between groups (as recommended by CDC).

The playground is NOT cleaned during the weekend so coming to campus during that time is not recommended.

**What about handwashing?** We are adding handwashing capacity in the elementary school by adding more operational sinks, and will be washing hands (one at a time with social distancing) multiple times each day, and specifically after recess and after lunch. Sanitizing stations will be in each classroom and are on each of our fields.

**Are you cleaning the buses?** Yes. School buses will be thoroughly sanitized by drivers between student runs.

**Are your staff trained and can they handle the volume of extra cleaning?** Our custodial staff has been trained and is capable of doing the required, but as needed we are able to bring in others to assist with this effort.
