FROM THE PRINCIPAL: I wanted to say **Thank You** for your continued understanding, patience, and flexibility during this school year. It is why we are able to continue following our outlined "return to learn" plan as scheduled in a productive manner. With that said, on March 29 we welcomed grades 4, 5, and 6. This means we now have K, 4-12 back in school four days a week, ahead of most districts. After Spring break (April 5-8), we will bring back grades 1, 2, 3 on April 12 and Preschool on April 19, then that is everyone. We will continue to follow guidance from the Lewis County Health Department. A couple of logistical reminders:

- Please have each student bring their attestation each morning. Teachers have extras if needed.
- Please stay home if your child is sick.
- If there is a question about your child's symptoms, please call us so we can evaluate the situation and follow proper protocol.
- If we continue to wear masks properly, we will limit quarantine possibilities if a positive case arises.
- Give us a call if you have any additional questions.

PE ELL SCHOOLS AWARDED OVER \$30,000 IN GRANTS

For the 2020 – 2021 school year, Pe Ell has been awarded several grants totaling over \$30,000.

TITLE V REAP GRANT:

Mr. Kepler: His CTE program was awarded \$9,000 to purchase BoBot 360s. These robots will allow students to learn programming for CNC routers and 3D printers – skills they can use to practice real-world manufacturing. The BoBots use a microprocessor that allows them to be programmed for a variety of tasks such as sensing moisture, temperature, and humidity levels.

Ms. Elliott: Her CTE middle school program received \$9,000 to purchase workstations for her classroom. These workstations not only organize the hardware at each student's workspace but also creates an atmosphere more like a real-world work area or office space rather than a traditional classroom.

PE Program: The PE program was awarded \$4,000 for two heavy-duty outdoor hoops to be placed on the tennis courts. These hoops will create additional activities for our outdoor PE classes. The extra hoops/courts will be available (in good weather) to the community members for play, exercise, and re-living the glory days.

WEYERHAEUSER GRANT: Since 2018, the Weyerhaeuser Company has awarded Pe Ell School with total grants of \$8,000 for library books and resources, as well as \$6,000 in 2020 for two outdoor heavy-duty basketball hoops for the PE program. Combined with the hoops purchased with the TITLE V REAP GRANT, we now have the equivalent of two full basketball courts.

AMAZON: Ms. Schimelpfenig, CTE Business, has been developing a computer technology class, IT202, since last year. As a result, the school has been awarded a grant from Amazon that allows students to learn how to program in the Python programming language. This language is one of the most popular programming languages in the world including the language Amazon uses to program its online applications. A college-level class, students are using the CANVAS learning management system to learn how to code in Python. It is hard to place a value on this grant, as it allows students to use this skill for college entrance and entry-level Python coding jobs. There are currently 10 students enrolled. COMPETITIVE GRANT: To further assist in the development of the new IT202 program, Ms. Schimelpfenig was also awarded a \$5,000 grant to purchase build-it-from-scratch computer kits and Python programming textbooks.
