Questions/Answers 4/15/21

 In regards to Line D on Page 7 about subs; Most organizations utilize local 3rd parties for their installation work, which is technically a sub. Is this line D in reference to the bidding company using local subs or the 3rd party that is submitted in the bid using subs outside their organization?

Answer: The bidder submitting the bid cannot sub any of the work out.

- In regards to Line E on Page 7 about licenses; If the installation company submitted is licensed, bonded, and insured in Florida, would that qualify on a conditional basis to meet the requirement of the bid if they plan to obtain their Alabama license?
 Answer: No, you must have an active Alabama Contractor's License prior to bidding for the appropriate work.
- In regards to Line B on Page 7 about warehousing; Will the district be warehousing these panels at their local facility? If not, where would they be located?
 Answer: The panels will be delivered to the schools in time for installation. This will be coordinated by MCPSS.
- In regards to Line B on Page 7 about warehousing; Will the contractor need to move the panels from the facility to the schools?
 Answer: The panels will be already at school for installation.
