

## BYOD Violation Procedures

The following are consequences that will occur if a student violates the BYOD guidelines. Actions will be taken according to the severity and frequency of the violation.

- Restriction of device usage or activity (teacher discretion).
- Parent/teacher/student conferences.
- Office discipline referral, administrative action.
- Serious violations will be subject to the MCPSS discipline policy



## BYOD Parent Responsibilities

- Support the MCPSS Acceptable Use Policy and Leinkauf Guidelines.
- Understand the security and internet filtering provided by MCPSS.
- Support copyright laws and internet safety.
- Troubleshoot and provide maintenance of their student's devices.
- Complete school surveys.
- Load any software or apps for student.

## FAQs about BYOD

- *What if my child's device is stolen or damaged?*

Students will bring approved devices at their own risk, just like any other personal items. The school will not be held responsible if a student's device or other item is lost, stolen, or misplaced. Some devices have locator applications such as Find My iPad; it is recommended that you enable this feature.

- *Who will pay for the apps on the device?*

The school is not responsible for the purchase of paid applications.

## What is BYOD?



Tablets are the perfect device for the BYOD program.

Leinkauf Elementary School is proud to announce the implementation of the Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program for 2nd through 5th grade students.

Participation in the program is completely optional. Students will have access technology activities whether

they bring a device or not.

In preparing our students for school and work in the 21st century, the BYOD program will provide greater access to resources allowing students to connect with learning environments beyond the Leinkauf classroom. The implementation of BYOD will integrate various technologies familiar to our students while allowing for quicker, easier access to information. This program will also grant students responsibility for their learning while fostering individual success.

We believe BYOD will increase access to digital resources and allow students to use their personal devices as powerful educational tools.



## Device Guidelines

- The student is responsible for taking care of their device. *Any damage that occurs to the device will not be the responsibility of Leinkauf Elementary or MCPSS.*
- Devices must be charged at home before coming to school each day. Teachers and school staff are not responsible for charging devices.
- Students must already be familiar with their device before bringing it to school. Each student should know how to turn their device on/off, turning on silent mode, and accessing the internet browser.
- Teachers and staff *will not* be responsible for training students how to use a personal device.
- All devices must be clearly labeled with the student's name.
- Devices should have a protective case to avoid damage.
- Devices must be powered off in the classroom until the teacher directs the students to turn devices on.
- *Leinkauf and MCPSS are not responsible for paid apps for personal devices.*
- *Students will not be allowed to share personal devices.*
- *Posting or sending images or video will be limited to that which is related to school assignments and projects and will be in accordance with MCPSS acceptable use policy.*

## Device Reminder

Students **are not** required to bring personal devices to Leinkauf. ALL students will have equal opportunity to participate in technology activities whether or not they bring a device to school.
