Chairman Vic Fleet called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. and Rick Little led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Jamie Ard presented the elementary school report. School is continuing to operate smoothly. There has been positive feedback from parents regarding the reopening. He has reached out to parents of students that are not completing virtual assignments.

Mr. Cleve Roland presented the middle school report. Guidelines are being followed for students/teachers quarantined for Covid. Temperatures are being taken and all procedures being regarded. Students are actively using google classroom. Rickey Green and others are assisting during Eric Thomas' absence. Currently have about 40 virtual students.

Dr. Bo Adams presented the high school report. So far the high school hasn't had a student test positive for Covid. They currently have about 60 virtual students. Those that are showing little progress have been contacted by him or the academic coaches. Several virtual students have returned to school due to internet issues. Mandy Long spoke on upcoming FFA events. She reports the greenhouse is still open for selling remaining plants.

Mr. Richard Bell presented information regarding the sale of property owned by the school district. Specifically, fifteen acres located between Milford St. and Perry St. He is asking the board to consider using him as the broker for this property.

Mr. Miller recommended approval of Personnel as follows. *All motions carried unanimously.*

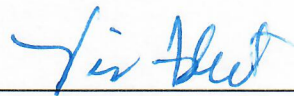
- *Phyllis Grant, Richard Caesar & Wesley Helms, Resignations - Motion, Mr. Little, seconded by Mr. Mock*
