Dear Parent or Guardian:

The 2020-2021 school year vaccination requirements for children entering Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, 7th and 11th grades are:

- All students entering Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten and 7th grade must have had two (2) varicella vaccinations before the first day of school.
- All students entering 7th grade must have had one Tdap vaccination and one meningococcal (MCV4) vaccination before the first day of school.
- Effective July 2020, all students entering or transferring into the 11th grade will need proof of a meningococcal conjugate booster (MCV4) shot, unless their 1st dose was received on or after their 16th birthday.

These requirements are in addition to the existing school vaccination requirements.

Make sure that all vaccines are up to date. Please schedule an appointment with your child's doctor or take your child to the local health department to have these required vaccines. In addition to the required vaccines, please talk to your child's doctor or Health Department about other vaccines, like flu, HPV and Hepatitis A that your child may need.

Please provide the school with the appropriate documentation that your child's vaccines are up to date (FORM 3231).

If you have questions about vaccines that are required for school, please call your child's doctor or the school nurse.
