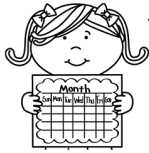

A Note From Mrs. N & Mrs. R



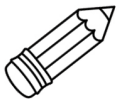

We are reading memoirs & biographies, and reviewing point of view, basic grammar skills, and figurative language.



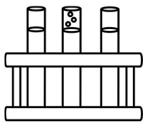
Writing
