

## Safety-Contact Tracing

**What is contact tracing and how will it work?** If a student becomes ill, contact tracing allows district personnel to account for everybody the student has come into contact with during the day. It allows us to “trace” a sequence of contacts throughout the day. This includes the bus, the classroom, and any other location the student goes within the day and is a list of all individuals who were within 6 feet of that person and unmasked. This is used when the student gets sick to inform families of potential risk and may be used by the Health Department to identify candidates for quarantine. Accordingly, the school district will be tracking each student and their contacts. This will necessitate assigned seating in any classroom setting and the bus.
