All responses must include the application, a photograph, and a transcript from the school. Return it to the School Counselor who will deliver it to the Pecan Valley Kiwanis Club for consideration.

- DUE DATE: The completed application must be returned to the School by Tuesday, April 27th, 2021.
- SECTION I: Complete this section by typing or printing on the application.
- SECTION II: Each of the five (5) components are to be typed on a separate page <u>in</u> <u>the requested format</u>, and attached to Section I. Please put your name at the top of each page (2), followed on the next line by the name of your high school, then the title.

These scholarships are available to seniors for higher education (Vo-Tech, College). Each winner will be given a certificate and a letter of instruction.

After graduating from high school, the student will receive the \$1,000 scholarship in two payments (2) of \$500 each. These can either go to the school or the student directly. After the student registers each semester, send a copy of the registered class schedule along with the student's account number to:

## SECTION II

Section II has five (5) components. **The answer for each component is to be on a separate sheet of paper.** At the top of each page, type or print your name. On the next line enter the name of your high school and list the page title on the third line. Each of your answers are to be on a single page, double spaced, with a font size of 10 or larger.

- List the clubs and organizations of which you are, or have been a member, and offices you have held. Briefly discuss an office or organization that has been especially meaningful to you. Title this page "Organizations".
- 2. How have you demonstrated LEADERSHIP ABILITY? Leadership may be defined as the ability to motivate others into action (Examples of demonstrating leadership are: Success in a youth organization, student government, school and community organizations, participation in athletic, dance, fine arts, effectively communicating to others either orally or in writing, by reaching others, etc.) Title this page "Leadership".
- 3. How have you shown the DESIRE TO LEARN AND SHARE KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE with others? (Examples of these desire are: asking questions and volunteering answers, joining discussion groups that are not required, researching a topic on your own offering to share your discovery with others, etc.) Title this page "**Knowledge and Experience**".
- 4. Volunteering or "serving" your community is an important aspect of the Kiwanis organization. Do you feel there is a need for young people, like yourself, to be involved in service to your community? Why or why not? Title this page "Volunteering and Service".
- 5. Goals and future plans. Goals are important as well as a plan to get there. What are your goals and future plans and how do you hope to achieve these goals. Title this page "**Goals and Future Plans**".
