Your child did not pass the above course work for this school year. Due to the current pandemic situation, Summer School will be offered virtually this year for students in grades 7-12 who need to recover credits and make-up the failed course work. Summer School will run from June 1-July 2, 2020.

All students will begin Summer School on **June 1st** regardless of the semester that they failed. The course work will be administered through a computer program called Edgenuity. Students will be expected to demonstrate academic integrity. Students who fail to meet those expectations may be dismissed from summer school coursework with no refund. Students will be expected to communicate with the facilitator via email in the Edgenuity program on a bi-weekly basis.

A student must complete the course work by 5:00 p.m., July 2, 2020, in order to receive credit. No refunds will be given because a student does not finish the work.

The cost of summer school is **\$75 per semester** for each course. Payment for Summer School fees will be taken at the central office on May 26, 27, 28 or June 1 and 2. After receiving payment, students will be given their access code to login to their coursework.
