***PARENT EDUCATION** conducts gatherings at schools, in community locations, and in the Family Center for parents/guardians and families.

***FAMILY ENGAGEMENT MEETINGS** provide training for students, parents, and families in ways to develop learning skills, life coping skills, parenting skills, and effective home/school communication skills.

***COMPUTER LAB** with internet access has computers available for parents/participants and students to help with their educational needs.

***PARENT AND TEACHER RESOURCES** lend parenting skills and teacher curriculum to be used by families at home and teachers in the schools.

***COMMUNITY OUTREACH** links parents, families, and teachers with community agencies and volunteers to lend help and support.

***SUBSTANCE AND PHYSICAL ABUSE PREVENTION** coordinates with teachers, the D.A.R.E. Officer, and school counselors to provide students and families with prevention skills, helpful information, and other materials.
