

# Seaside School District Proposed Plan

## Student Investment Account (SIA) Summary

Dear Seaside School District Families and Staff,

On March 17 the Seaside School District Board of Directors approved the Seaside School District's Proposed Student Investment Account plan. This draft was developed through a detailed community engagement process and work sessions with our certified and classified planning team, with final recommendations going to our administrative planning team. This important work focuses on the needs of the District's historically underserved populations, including students of color, emerging bilinguals, students navigating poverty, and students with disabilities.

Our process for developing this SIA plan began in September 2019. We spent time in the fall engaging our families and staff with a district-wide survey, individual interviews with students and families of students with disabilities, roundtable discussions with our Latinx families, and connecting with families during community events, such as Project Homeless Connect. We want to thank all of you who took the time to share this important information with us.

After completing engagement work, we began working with our planning teams. A certified and classified team of 10 worked through a facilitated protocol of analyzing district data, community engagement data, and research-based best practices, to develop a list of recommendations. These recommendations were brought to our administrative leadership team for final review.

This final draft plan was then presented to the community on March 10, 2020 at Broadway Middle School in both English and Spanish. As stated above, our school board approved the proposed plan on March 17, 2020 during our regular monthly public meeting.

By leading with equity throughout the development of this plan, we are confident we are better prepared to serve our students, families, and community.
