Course Name: Senior High Band I/II

Length of Course: Year

Grade Level: 9-12

Course Description:

Senior High Band is a performance-based course in the study of instrumental music. Building on musical skills and knowledge developed in Junior High Band, students in Senior High Band will rehearse and perform concert band and wind ensemble literature ranging in difficulty from medium to advanced. While the main focus of Senior High Band is instrumental performance, students will also develop and demonstrate the ability to interpret and analyze music and musical performances in a variety of contexts.

Senior High Band is a co-curricular subject. This means that performances outside of regular class time will be reflected in the student's final grade. These performances include concerts, pep bands, graduation, Memorial Day, and large-group contest.

Participation in Marching Band is strongly encouraged for all students enrolled in Senior High Band. Jazz Band, Pit Band, and Solo/Ensemble Contest are additional opportunities for musical performance available to students in Senior High Band.
