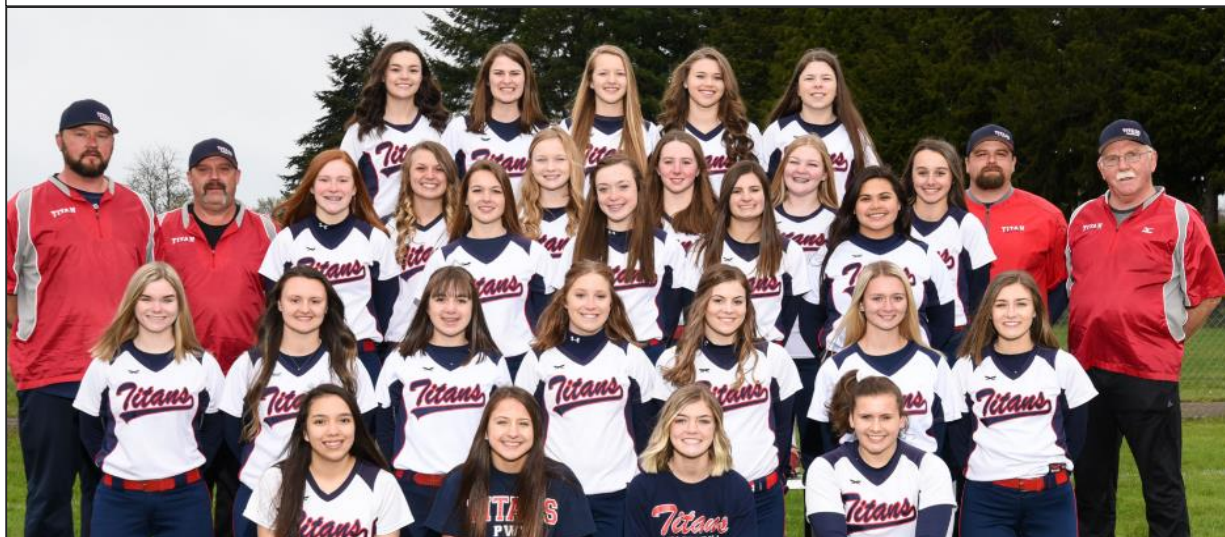
ALL SPORTS MEETING
