3:00	<p>Confession</p> <p>The word palm can mean one of two things: It can mean the leafy branches that were lifted with shouts of Hosanna on Palm Sunday or it can be referring to our physical palms of our hands. In this time of confession, I want us to do something a little different than we normally do but can help us acknowledge our sinfulness and need of a Savior.</p> <p>We heard how damaging hypocrisy can be among God's people. One of the ways to limit this damage is to be honest with ourselves, with God, and with one another about who we are. I want all of us to take a moment and raise our palms, our hands, confessing that we are sinners and need the forgiveness God gives.</p> <p>(Have congregation raise palms: wait a few seconds to let people look around)</p> <p>When we sin against one another, against God, against our families rather than covering it up we can admit that we need forgiveness. Rather than covering up our actions and living in hypocrisy, we can boldly ask God for forgiveness.</p>	Switch to Jeff			
2:00	<p>Absolution</p> <p>(Invite Congregation to put palms down)</p> <p>We just saw it. Everyone gathered here today is a sinner in need of forgiveness. This doesn't excuse our sin but it directs us to who alone can and has done something about it, Jesus Christ.</p> <p>God spoke through the prophet Isaiah about how he will never forget or forsake his people when he said, "Behold, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands; your walls are continually before me." Not only has God not forgotten his people, but he also died for his people. Our sins have been forgiven as Christ's palms were nailed to a cross and he took your sins and my sins to himself. I announce to you today that your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.</p> <p>Amen.</p>	Stay on Jeff
